What we will be doing in school	How you can help at home
Maths- Multiplication	
<ul> <li>This week we will look at multiplication which will include a range of elements:</li> <li>Looking at times tables and linking our counting skills in 2s, 3s and 5s to the times tables.</li> <li>The concept of repeated addition and how this links to multiplication</li> </ul>	The children will be given strategies for working out their multiplication tables, but it frees up ever such a lot of brain space if they can put it in their long term memory rather than having to work it out every time! This takes a bit of time, so it's a really great thing to do at home- a little bit each day:
e.g. 2+2+2=6 3x2=6	Write out the tables and their answers.
<ul> <li>Using arrays to explore multiplication e.g.</li> <li> <ul> <li></li></ul></li></ul>	Write out the facts on post it notes, stick them all over the house and play a treasure hunt with them. When they are all found, put them in order.
<ul> <li>4 × □ = 8</li> </ul>	Get your child to make a times table quiz for you! In being the quiz master they will have to know and check the answers you give. (See what happens when you get one wrong!!)

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<u>Topic-What a Wonderful World!</u>	
Geography: We will use a range of sources this week to find out all about India. Talk about different traditions that you celebrate as a family and compare these to another country.
Science: We will be investigating how to make a bulb light up and what happens when we change the circuit, for example, adding more batteries. We will learn about Thomas Edison and his invention of the long lasting light bulb.	
Art: We will begin to turn our attention to the Christmas decorations for the school. Each class will prepare a Christmas display for the hall. The grand reveal will be on the 29 <sup>th</sup> November.	
PSHE: The children will be reading the story of 'Ruby's Worry' by Tom Percival and discussing what they can do with their worries and who they can speak to.
