### Activities

Get two plates and put sweets or toys onto each plate.



How many objects are there altogether? How can you find out?

You can write the number sentences if you want to.

$$5 + 3 = 8$$

An investigation!

You can also investigate the different ways to make numbers. For example,  $1+1+3=5$ ,  $4+1=5$ . Use objects to help you.

You could draw or write your findings in your green books.

Revise the **ee** sound by watching Geraldine the Giraffe.



### Challenge


Can you write a sentence with an **ee** word in? For example, The queen went to sleep. How many sentences can you write?

Is this a story or information book?


How do we know that it is an information book?
