You could use paper, whiteboard or chalk board. Check they are formed correctly.</p> <p>Can you write them on small pieces of paper and put them in order? If you turn one over, can your child say what that hidden number is?</p>
<p><b>PHONICS</b></p>	<p>Revise phase 2 sounds. Watch Geraldine the Giraffe: <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=IRTITdRL_cU">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=IRTITdRL_cU</a></p>	<p>Watch <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Z-0wWdE-Ezg">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Z-0wWdE-Ezg</a></p> <p>Listen to the explanation of the sound at the beginning then turn the sound off and ask your child to sound out and blend the words. Then, play the film again with the sound on. See how many oi words they can write down. Can they think of any other words?</p> <p><b>Challenge</b> Can they write a sentence with an oi word in? For example, The coin is in the soil. How many sentences can they write?</p>

		<p>Don't forget to leave finger spaces. Remember to use a capital letter at the start of your sentence and a full stop.</p>
<p><b>TOPIC DINOSAURS</b></p>	<p>Look at the dinosaur scenes below.</p> <p>Talk with your children about the different scenes.</p> <p>What can they see? What do they notice?</p> 	<p>What can you see in the different scenes? How could you describe them? What else do you know about where dinosaurs lived?</p> <p>Imagine you are a dinosaur and move around as if you are in the scenes! How would you move in water? How would you move through trees?</p> <p>Can you create a picture of a dinosaur scene? You could draw, paint, use collage materials or even a 3d scene.</p>
