Suggestions for activities at home

Topic / General

Will you be celebrating Easter? Talk to your child about Easter, or festivals and traditions that you celebrate. What traditions do you have?

Your child could practise cutting with scissors by cutting out egg shapes.

You can then decorate the eggs and use them to make decorations, cards (see Wednesday activity) or even to put them in your window so children can go on an 'egg hunt' if you go out for a walk.



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Use some of your egg decorations to make Easter Cards for family and friends. You could take photos of them and send the photos.

You could decorate or make an Easter basket out of paper or card



You can use A4 size paper, prepare the template then children can do the cutting, sticking and decorating.



You could prepare an Easter Egg hunt around the house or garden. Ask your child to count how many eggs your child can find on an Easter Egg Hunt.

You could try an alternative to chocolate eggs by having numbers written on paper inside plastic eggs, or make egg cards with numbers on them. Encourage your child to find all the numbers, e.g. 1 to 10 and check if they have found them all by putting them in order.



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Sing songs and recite nursery rhymes.
