



TUESDAY	Teach	Activities
MATHS	<p><b>Read</b></p> <p>Today, we are going to do some sequencing.</p> <p>Read the 3 Billy Goats Gruff or your favourite stories and talk about what happens first, next and last.</p>	<p><b>Play</b></p> <p>Have a go at instructing each other to do everyday tasks. You could draw the instructions too. For example, for teeth brushing:</p> <p><b>First</b>, get your toothbrush and put toothpaste on it. <b>Next</b>, brush your teeth <b>Last</b>, put your toothbrush away</p> <p>You could try different activities such as eating a banana, getting dressed or making a sandwich, etc.</p> 

<p><b>PHONICS</b></p>	<p>Practise your sounds, tricky words or high frequency words using the films on the website.</p> <p>Read Toads in the road on the Oxford Owl website.  <a href="https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/api/digital_books/2095.html">https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/api/digital_books/2095.html</a></p>  <p>Try to read it by yourself first and then play the audio or play the audio and then repeat afterwards. When you hear or see an oa word put your finger on your nose.</p>	<p>Look at the list of <b>oa</b> words you wrote yesterday.</p> <p><b>Challenge</b>  Can you write a sentence with as many <b>oa</b> words in as you can? For example,</p> <p>The goat had a coat and sat in a boat.</p> <p>You could also draw a picture to go with your sentence.  How many sentences can you write? Don't forget to use a capital letter, finger spaces and a full stop.</p>
