Monday	Teach	Activities
Phonics Phonic sounds the week: aw, ph, wh.	<p>Today's sound is 'ph' as in 'phone'. Write it down for your child to copy a few times, saying it as they do so.</p> <p>Ph – some 'ph' words are - dolphin, phone, alphabet, phantom, elephant, nephew.</p> <p>Remember to practise yesterday's spellings: plant, grass, pretty, wild, water, path, people, beautiful.</p>	<p>You could have a go on Phonics Play and set which ever game you play to use 'ph' words.</p> <p>So, when you go into to 'Buried Treasure' for example, click on Phase 5, then on 'ph' for lots of words, nonsense and real, for that sound.</p>
English Book of the Week:	<p>Before starting today's work have a look at the PowerPoint for today on the website. Today your child is going to design their very own Anywhere Garden!</p>	<p>Draw the garden (leaving some space around the outside to add something tomorrow!)</p>

The Curious Gardener

1. Think of where they would like the garden to be. Perhaps they have a real-life location in mind; some

2. What are they going to plant in - as you can see from the PowerPoint, there are a lot of different unusual things that plants can be planted in – which ones will your child choose?

What are they going to plant in their 'Anywhere Garden'? Are they going to plant flowers and plants that look or smell amazing? Or are they going to plants that give fruit or berries, or even a herb garden or plants that have medicinal benefits?

Write some sentences about what is in their garden, and maybe why you chose those plants. Challenge them to get adjectives (describing words) in the sentences.

Try to add this week's spellings e.g.

'In my anywhere garden I planted a small strawberry plant / a beautiful rose bush / a large apple tree / some pretty, wild flowers'.

'I chose tomato plants because tomatoes are my favourite fruit / because I like to eat tomatoes for my lunch.'

'I will water my plants every day so they grow.'

Think about part 3 and give your reasons for your answer. 😊


We will now move onto **finding a quarter** using the video clip to support the task. There is time to explore **finding a quarter** and examples of today's activities.


