Can you choose your favourite toy and act out the order of the day? What happens during different parts of the day?


You could draw your routine. You could ask another family member to draw out their routine, is it the same or different?

<p>TOPIC</p> <p>Traditional stories- Once Upon a Tale</p>	<p>This week, we will focus on the story of Little Red Riding Hood.</p> <p>Read or watch the story https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=0W86K1jBJFI</p>  <p>We will think about how traditional stories are structured. Traditional stories usually have a problem and a solution. A solution is a way of solving a problem.</p> <p>What do you think is the problem in the story?</p>	<p>It is creation and design time!</p> <p>Can you think of a way for Little Red Riding Hood to get the food to her granny without meeting the wolf?</p> <p>What did you design? How will it work?</p> <p>Test your ideas with some soft toys. You could also test it with food.</p>

	<p>How is the problem solved?</p>	 <p>You may also want to design something new for Little Red Riding Hood to carry the food to granny in.</p>
