

**Nursery Weekly Home Learning Suggestions**  
**Week Beginning 29<sup>th</sup>**  
**June 2020**

**Suggestions for activities at home**

For the next 3 weeks, we are going to be taking part in whole school topics. This week's topic is **Superheroes**. As your child is going to be in school for 2 days, there are 3 days of home learning activities for you to have a go at. As always enjoy and let us know what you have been up to.

**Day 1**

Watch Supertato. Can you think of any other Superheroes? What are their powers? Have a discussion with your child about real life superheroes. Can you think of any people who have helped us during the current pandemic? Here are some examples, delivery drivers, supermarket workers, postal workers, doctors, police officers, nurses, cleaners, carers and refuse collectors. Can you think of anymore? Can you draw a picture of someone who helps us? Maybe you know somebody who is a real like superhero.

**Maths**

Go on a shape hunt. Can you find any 2d shapes including circles, triangles, squares and rectangles? For a challenge you could try and find a pentagon or hexagon.

**Day 2**

Can you use some figures to tell a story about a superhero. You could use happy land people, mini figures, Playmobil, Lego people etc. What is their superpower and how will they use it?

**Maths**

Can you design a building for a superhero to live in?

Cut out some different shapes including squares, rectangles, circles and triangles. Ask your to child to make a landscape or a building picture out of them.



**Day 3**

Can you make a mask and be a superhero?

Choose a template and colour in your mask? What colours will you use and design?

**Maths**

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Today we are going to continue exploring shape. Using any kind of construction set, can your child build a city or setting for a superhero to live in?



### Phonics- through the week

This week we are going to do some learning around syllables. Words can be broken into syllables. Watch the video for a more thorough explanation.

Clap some words and see if you can see how many syllables are in each word. For example, cat has 1 syllable and puddle has 2. Instead of clapping you could try hitting sticks together or stamping.

Count how many times your chin drops when you say a word. This tells you how many syllables are in a word.

### Other

Practise writing your name using the template we gave you. Try to form the letters correctly.

Choose some of the colour by shape pictures to colour in.

Have a go at a Superhero workout


