


This Week in Reception

Our Topic: Marvellous Minibeasts

What we will be doing in school	How you can help at home
<p><u>Topic-Mythical Creatures</u></p> <p>We will learn about mythical creatures such as dragons and unicorns.</p> <p>The children will describe what they have enjoyed during their time in Reception.</p>	<p>Read every day with your child (ideally reading to them as well as them reading to you). A few minutes every day is better than longer sessions infrequently!</p> <p>Try writing a diary with a sentence each day to say what you have done in the holiday.</p> <p>Visit interesting places: museums, the library, parks or even a zoo or farm.</p>
<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>In Maths, we will be revisiting concepts covered throughout the year including 2D and 3D shapes, money and time.</p> 	<p>Looks for 2D and 3D shapes in the environment. Practise writing numerals to 20 ensuring correct number formation and orientation.</p> <p>An interesting game you can play with your child. https://www.doorwayonline.org.uk/activities/cashing-in.html.</p> <p>Play games estimating and ordering two or three items by length or height, weight and size. Practise adding and subtracting using household objects.</p>
<p><u>Phonics and tricky words</u></p> <p><u>Sounds taught so far:</u> c, o, a, d, g, f, s, e, l, i, t, u, y, j, r, n, m, p, h, b, k, v, w, x, z, qu, ll, ss, ff, zz, sh, ch, th, ck, oo, oo, ee, or, ar, ng, ai, oi, oa, ear, air, ur, igh, ow, er.</p> <p><u>Tricky words taught so far:</u> the, to, I, you, was, no, go, me, my, he, be, like, have, we, some, they, all, she, are, come.</p> <p><u>Other high frequency words taught so far:</u> yes, from, this, that, then, dear, from, went, his.</p>	<p>You could play Dragon's Den with your child. Select the sounds that we have learnt or the sounds that your child finds tricky. Blend the words and drag the real words onto the green dragon and the made up words onto the red one.</p> <p>https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/resources/phase/3/dragons-den</p>  <p>You could also practise letter formation with your child, ensuring that they use the correct formation and orientation e.g. checking that their 's' is the right way around or that their 'd' starts in the right place.</p>
