What we will be doing in school	How you can help at home
<p><u>English - Recipes and more</u></p> <p>This week is chocolate week. I have spent all week trying not to drool over lots of yummy chocolate delights and plans we have in store.</p> <p>The children will be designing their dream chocolate bar and writing a description about it to sell to Willy Wonka for him to make. They will read the story <i>Chocolate Cake</i> by Michael Rosen and write a diary entry, an apology letter and talk about onomatopoeias. During the week the children will do some baking with Mrs Gunstone and Miss Zara and then will write up their recipes.</p>	<p>Perhaps you would like to make something over the weekend together or make dinner together one evening. Ask your child to help read out the recipe (you may want to double check quantities) and talk about how recipes are laid out.</p> 
<p><u>Maths - Addition</u></p> <p>This week the children will continue to focus on addition and subtraction. They will be adding up the costs of different chocolate bars and working out how much change they will get if they were to buy them.</p>	<p>Keep working on number bonds to 20. It is such an important skill to learn and will support how they begin to mentally figure out number sentences in their heads. If you fancy doing some recipe making as above then maybe you can ask your child to practice their weighing and measuring skills with the ingredients.</p>
<p><u>Science - Chocolate Feasts</u></p> <p>This week the children will have a go at different chocolate experiments. They will be investigating which chocolates sink or float, which type of chocolate melts the fastest as well as learning about the lifecycle of chocolate! Yum!</p>	<p>Here is another experiment you may want to try together at home. (Please be careful with hot water!) The Year 1s will not be studying molecular structure but you can talk about this in terms of an object changing shape, size and colour.</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=LFqXJc_7c54</p> <p>Let us know how you get on!</p> 
<p><u>DT - Baking</u></p> <p>This week the children will be doing some baking.
