




# Next Week in Year 1

## Week Beginning 5<sup>th</sup> October 2020



This week we will be focusing on our sense of sight!

What we will be doing in school	How you can help at home
<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Maths- Place Value</u></b></p> <p>This week we are beginning our work on addition. We will use 'part-whole models' to support our learning of addition facts within 10.</p> <p>Children are introduced to the addition symbol (+) for the first time in Year 1. They will combine this with the 'equal to' symbol (=) to create their first number sentences e.g. <math>3 + 2 = 5</math>. They will use the a 'part, part, whole' model, using objects, pictures and then digits in these models to support them in creating and recording addition sentences.</p> <p>The children will work on gaining a secure grasp of 'bonds within 10' so that they can quickly recall multiple addition facts for a given number. E.g) <math>1+4=5</math>, <math>4+1=5</math>, <math>2+3=5</math>, <math>3+2=5</math>.</p>	<p>Why not enjoy spotting signs of Autumn and collecting objects to use for some maths work this weekend?! Draw 3 circles, large on the ground with hoops or chalk, or just on a piece of paper! Then use leaves, conkers, seeds or anything you can find to put into 2 of the circles (your two 'parts'). Then add them up to find the whole! Can you change your 'parts' to make this whole in lots of different ways?!</p> <p>How will you record your answers? Remember to bring in any work you do to add to our maths working walls!</p> 
<p><b><u>English- Panda Bear, Panda Bear, what do you see?</u></b></p> <p>We are continuing to explore our senses this week by focusing on our sense of sight. We will be taking the children on a walk around the school and asking them to write down any interesting things that they see, be that natural things like creepy crawlies and plants, or unnatural things like brick walls and the teacher's cars! We will be questioning them on how best to describe these things that they see, and creating wonderful word banks to use later in the week.</p> <p>We will be reading the story "Panda Bear, Panda Bear, what do you see?" By Eric Carle and Bill Martin Jr. The children will be writing short character descriptions for some of the animals in the story. They will also pretend they are the sleeping child and tell us what they dreamt of in their sleeping heads.</p>	<p>Have a go at some observational drawings over the weekend. Whilst the children are drawing get them to talk about the shapes and colours of different objects. They can try and note down these words and bring them in to add them to our class word banks!</p> 



## Next Week in Year 1 Week Beginning 5<sup>th</sup> October 2020



This week we will be focusing on our sense of sight!

### Phonics

We will introduce the children to new Phase 3 sounds:  
**oo (moon), oo (book), ar, or**

These sounds will be taught alongside words of the week. We will add a new word of the week every week, and we would advise that you work on recognising these within reading sessions, as well as learning to spell them correctly.

This week the word will be:

**my**

Please continue to use the taught Phonics sounds when decoding words with your children as they read.

Top Tip - If you look in the middle of your reading records, you will find both phonics sounds and words that you can practice reading with your child.

Try to practice writing the words of the week at home.

### Topic- Super Senses

**Science:** As we will be focussing on the sense of sight we will look at what body part we use to do this and how it works. We will investigate how the eye changes to match the amount of light that is around us and will also see how tricky it is to follow instructions with our sight. We will also get busy making homemade lava lamps for Panda Bear and then think about what it is we are seeing and why it is happening.

**Computing:** We will continue to work with Beebots. We will look to see if we can program the Beebots to follow paths we create.

**Art:** The children will continue their final Kandinsky piece. They will look to use a variety of mediums to paint, draw and mark the lines and shapes that will form their background.

Have fun creating and doing your own eye tests at home. Who has the best eyesight? Do they have the best far away and close up?





## Next Week in Year 1 Week Beginning 5<sup>th</sup> October 2020



**This week we will be focusing on our sense of sight!**

**RE:** We will turn to the Islamic story of creation and look at how Muslim's believe the world came into existence. We will discuss how they praise and thank Allah for His creations.
