What we will be doing in school	How you can help at home
<p><u>Topic - We're Going on a Bear Hunt</u> Next week we are going to be reading the books 'Peace at Last' and 'Whatever Next'. We will talk about fireworks and we will think about some of the sounds the children hear. We will then write a class poem using some of these words.</p>  <p>We will talk about Remembrance Day and why is it important.</p>	<p>If you saw and heard any fireworks this weekend, ask your child to describe the sounds that they hear, e.g. whizz or bang.</p> <p>Can they think of any words that sound like or rhyme with another word? For example, fizz and whizz.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <p>We will explore how to make different numbers, for example, five can be made by adding 4 and 1 or 3 and 2.</p> 	<p>Ask your child to pick a number between 3 and 10. Using objects such as toy cars or Lego, can they find different ways to make the number?</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Phonics and tricky words</u></p> <p><u>New sounds: r, n and m.</u> <u>New tricky word: into.</u></p> <p>We will practise hearing and saying the sounds in words (segmenting), e.g. rag and blending to read words. You can encourage your child to make rhyming words by changing the initial letter sound in the words. For example, mat, cat, fat, hat, pat, bat, etc.</p> <p>Sounds taught so far: c, o, a, d, g, f, s, e, l, i, t, u, y, j.</p> <p>Tricky words taught so far: the, I, to, no ang go.</p> 	<p>Try a robot game: Draw a picture and encourage your child to move as a robot as they say each sound. For example, f- r-o-g. Encourage emphasis on each sound. Don't forget to have a go yourself!</p> <p>Please remember to read with your child for at least 10 minutes a day and add comments to the reading record books.</p> <p>Sometimes, your child might like to choose a reading book that they may have read before. It is good to re-read the book again. As we teach them more letter sounds, they will enjoy reading independently or with little help.</p>

We will create fireworks pictures.

We will use natural materials to create pieces of art.

We will explore seasonal changes in our outdoor areas.
