


# Next Week in Reception

## Week Beginning 30<sup>th</sup> November 2020

What we will be doing in school	How you can help at home
<p><b><u>Topic - We're Going on a Bear Hunt</u></b>            We will find out about bears. We will explore when and why they hibernate. The children will also write numbered lists about how to prepare for Christmas. Later in the week, the children will write a Christmas wish list!</p> 	<p>Try reading some non-fiction books at home to find out information. Look at the contents page and discuss how to use it. What do bears do to prepare for hibernation? Talk about and use question words: where, when, what, why, who, how. Look out for questions and question marks when you are reading with your child. Encourage your child to use their sounds if writing a letter or list for Santa.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Maths</u></b></p> <p>We will be working on 1 less than a given number.</p> 	<p>Practise counting down to become more familiar with number order. Try some practical problems involving one less, e.g. I had eight grapes, I have eaten one. How many are left?            Sing songs such as Ten in a Bed, Ten Green Bottles, Five Little Speckled Frogs and Five Little Men in a Flying Saucer.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Phonics</u></b></p> <p><b><u>New sounds: z, x and qu</u></b>  <b><u>New tricky words: you and be.</u></b></p> <p>Sounds taught so far: c, o, a, d, g, f, s, e, l, i, t, u, y, j, r, n, m, p, h, b, k, v, w            Tricky words taught so far: the, to, I, no, go into, she, he, me, we,</p> 	<p>Try a robot game: Draw a picture and encourage your child to move as a robot as they say each sound. For example, f- r-o-g. Encourage emphasis on each sound. Don't forget to have a go yourself!</p> <p>Create a tricky word Bingo game to play together. Your child could try writing the words.</p>
