


Next Week in Reception

What we will be doing in school	How you can help at home
<p><u>Topic - We're Going on a Bear Hunt</u> This week, we will learn about the Nativity story. We will be learning about the characters in the story and making booklets.</p>	<p>Talk about the Nativity story at home. You could look at how Christmas is celebrated around the world. You could also look at other celebrations such as Hanukkah.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <p>We will introduce 3D shapes and begin to use mathematical names for 'solid' 3D shapes. The children will assist Santa and help him wrap up 3D shaped presents in Santa's workshop! We will be using 3D shape vocabulary such as edge, corner, face and cube, cuboid, sphere, cylinder and pyramid.</p> 	<p>Play games like I spy - Which 3D shapes can you spy when you are at home or out and about with your child? You could speak about the properties of 3D shapes; it has four corners, or 12 edges, a flat or rounded surface etc.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Phonics and tricky words</u></p> <p><u>New sounds: ck, ss and zz</u> <u>New words: will was and my</u></p> <p>Sounds taught so far: c, o, a, d, g, f, s, e, l, i, t, u, y, j, r, n, m, p, h, b, k, v, w, x, z, qu Tricky words taught so far: the, to, I, no, go into, she, he, me, we, be, you</p> 	<p>Play a word hunt game- Write words and hide them around your home or garden. Support our child to hunt for the words and to read them. They could then write the words for you to find!</p>
