

Roll the dice twice and add the totals. How many spaces should you move forward? Who will win?</p>  <p>Questions to ask your child- How can you find out? What could you do? What did you do?</p>

What do you notice?</p> <p>Challenge Roll a dice twice. Can you find the highest score you can make? What did you find out?</p>  <p>Try writing number sentences to show what you found. For example, $4 + 4 = 8$. Ask your grown-up for help if needed.</p>
