


Home Learning Week 7 22.2.21

Foundation Subjects: Science, Art, Geography, RE, P.E

Choose one of these subjects each day to complete in the afternoon.

	Teach	Activities
Science	<p>Outcome: Research and create a fact file, poster or leaflet about an animal of your choice.</p> <p>This half term our new topic is 'Go Wild' with a focus on the amazing animals and wonderful places in our world.</p> <p>Watch 'Science Teacher Video' This will introduce the children to some awesome animals and introduce the task.</p> <p>In Science today the children will get the chance to share what they know about an animal of their choice. Their task is to create a fact file, leaflet or poster about that animal.</p>  	<p>Create a fact file, leaflet or poster about any animal you choose.</p> <p>Tell us what you know about the animal (you might want to research online or with books).</p> <p>Ideas for info might be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Where does it live? What does it look like? What does it eat? How big can it get? How does it protect itself? Anything interesting about your animal? <p>Look to make your fact file, leaflet/poster colourful and eye-catching. Draw or print out pictures of the animal you have chosen to go on the poster.</p> 

Art	<p>Outcome: Create a lion painting/collage complete with mane!</p> <p>Today the children will create some Lion based art with Mrs Gunstone.</p> <p>Watch the 'Teacher Art video'. This will give step by step instructions of how to draw a lion face, paint it and collage for the mane. Pausing at each step and completing it yourself may prove helpful.</p> <p>*If you do not have paint you can create your own by following the instructions on 'How to make your own paint' video. Alternatively, colouring with pencils, felt tips or collaging for all is fine – whatever works best for you guys!</p> 	<p>Create a lion painting/collage complete with mane!</p> <p><<<<<<</p> <p>You'll need:</p> <p>Paper</p> <p>Pencil</p> <p>Paint (can make own or use other method to colour)</p> <p>Coloured paper (to collage mane – can colour plain paper with pencils/paint if you don't have any)</p>
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Geography	<p>Outcome: On a map of Europe, draw and label animals that live in Europe!</p> <p>In Geography this half term, we will be looking at the continents and oceans of the world. Watch 'Geography Teacher Video' This will introduce the children to our unique world. It will briefly introduce the continents and oceans before focussing on the continent of Europe. In the video there is a place to pause, so you can search for the continent of Europe either using an atlas or on Google Earth https://www.google.co.uk/intl/en_uk/earth/ The video will then go on to introduce key facts about Europe and animals that live in the continent. The video will then introduce the task. The children's task today will be to draw and label animals onto a map of Europe.</p>  <p>© 2019 Balloon Media. Art by Sara Lynn Cramb.</p>	<p>Task: Draw and label animals onto a map of Europe.</p> <p>(either use the printable map or draw your own)</p> <p>You can draw the animals mentioned in the video onto the map of Europe. If your child want's they could also draw animals that are not in the slides but do still live in Europe. (They may already know these animals but also might want to research)</p> <p>*(The animals don't have to go to be placed in the exact area/country they live)</p> <p>After, and if you have space, you can then label your animals. Finally add some colour.</p>

RE	<p>Outcome: Watch The story of 'Jesus and the Loaves and the Fishes'. Think about/discuss the questions.</p> <p>Watch the 'RE Teacher Video'. It will be focussing on Christianity and lessons Christians take from the things Jesus did. We will look at the Christian story of 'The Feeding of the 5000' via a clip. (*Here's the link if you want to watch it again and full screen https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/clips/z3fdwmn) After the video we will then think about some questions to do with the story.</p> 	<p>Pause and think about the questions in the teach video. Discuss with an adult if able.</p> <p>After you've had thinking time, un pause and I'll share my thoughts on the questions.</p>
