





MATHS	<p>Today we will focus on telling the time to the half hour.</p> <p>Watch-Independent viewing Miss Burr's Telling the Time to the Half Hour video.</p> <p>Watch Telling the time to the half hour. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=n_daAYx6krg</p>  <p>Questions to ask your child- What can you see? How can you tell? If the shorter hand is pointing at five, what time will it be?</p>	<p>Look at your watch or clock. Where is the long hand pointing? If it is pointing at 6, then it is half past the hour.</p> <p>Play https://www.turacogames.com/games/telling-time-space-math-game-for-kids/</p>  <p>Have a go at matching a clock and the time. You could use building blocks or any other objects you can think of. You could mix up the times for your grown-ups to match!</p>

You will need to select the letters you want to try. https://www.doorwayonline.org.uk/activities/letterformation/</p> <p>*CGP Handwriting book Your child could complete page 16.</p> <p>Challenge Can your child complete pages 17-19.</p>	<p>Parents need to supervise this writing activity to ensure the correct orientation and starting point of the letters.</p> <p>Write each letter following Mrs Rodrigues' video then write the letters in your book at least five times.</p> <p>Remember the starting point for each of these letters is at the top.</p> <p>You will need your exercise book and a pencil.</p>  <p>Challenge Practise writing all of the letters of the alphabet in your Handwriting book.</p>
