MATHS	<p>Today we will practise writing numbers.</p> <p>Watch-Independent viewing Miss Burr's Writing Numbers video (a new character will be introduced- watch from around 4 minutes).</p> <p>You will need your exercise book and a pencil.</p> <p>Watch Numberblocks Song- Let's All Draw Numbers https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=8ii202RoEd8</p> 	<p>Practise writing numbers on a large piece of paper. You could write in paint or with chalk, outside.</p>  <p>Challenge Try writing larger numbers. Which is the larger number you can write?</p>

Sounds taught so far: c, o, a, d, g, f, s, e, l, l, t, u, y, j, r, n, m, p, h, b, k, v, w, x, z, qu, ck, ss, zz, ff, ll, sh, ch, th, oo, oo, or, ee, ai, oa

Tricky words taught so far: the, to, l, no, go into, she, he, me, we, be, you, was, my, they, all, are, have, said

Today we will revise letter names, and practise writing the capital letters: A, B, D, E, F.
