




Thursday February 11th Remote Learning

They begin 3-4 steps away from the pots. • Players race to throw their ball into one of the pots. First to four successful throws wins the round. • In between each throw you must complete 10 squats. • In the next round change the exercise you need to complete in between the throws. <p>Make this easier by using a bigger pot. Who won the most rounds?</p>  </div>
