- To resolve conflict to get along with their friends.
- Looking after school property and their own things.
- New school values- Appreciation and curiosity

Understanding the World

- To find out about dinosaurs and how they lived.
- Use IT to find out information.
- Learning the meaning of new vocabulary e.g. extinct, carnivore, herbivore, habitats, etc.
- To find out the habitats of different dinosaurs.
- To identify the different types of dinosaurs by their features.

Literacy, Communication & Language

Communication and Language:

- To speak clearly with confidence during whole class discussions and with friends.
- To be confident at asking questions and finding out information about interests.
- Using talk to resolve problems and conflicts.

Writing:

- To write words and sentences using phonic knowledge and key words when writing lists, recipes and labelling.
- To start to use descriptive language when writing captions about dinosaurs.

Reading:

- To know the difference between a story book and an information book (fiction/non-fiction).

Physical Development

- To be able to hold a pencil effectively and use it with good control.
- To be able to use small games equipment with more control e.g. bats and balls.
- To experiment with moving around in different ways demonstrating good spatial awareness and body control.

- To enjoy joining in with dancing and songs and create dinosaur music using instruments and movements to represent dinosaurs.
- To create junk models of dinosaurs.
- To use a variety of media to create different textures.

Maths

- To continue to practise ordering by length, height, weight and capacity using non-standard units of measure.
- To understand one more and one less with numbers up to 20, focusing on numbers to 10.
- To explore addition and subtraction number problems.
