


# Next Week in Reception

## Week Beginning 19<sup>th</sup> April 2021

What we will be doing in school	How you can help at home
<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Topic - Traditional Tales</u></b></p> <p>We will introduce our new topic and our first story is The Three Billy Goats Gruff. We will be retelling and sequencing our story. We will also be learning to write speech bubbles.</p> 	<p>Over the holiday, read traditional tales from around the world and talk about the characters and settings. Discuss your child's favourite parts of the story. Your child could have a go at writing their favourite part of the story. Talk about the stories you read to them. Do they have a favourite story?</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Maths</u></b></p> <p>We will explore subitising- The ability to look at a number of objects and to recognise how many objects there are without needing to count.</p> 	<p>Your child could use any objects you have such as toy cars or wooden blocks to work out how to represent different numbers. Perhaps you could make a Bingo game with different ways to show amounts.</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Phonics</u></b></p> <p><b><u>New sounds: ow, er and igh</u></b></p> <p><b><u>New tricky word: her</u></b></p> <p>Sounds taught so far: c, o, a, d, g, f, s, e, l, i, t, u, y, j, r, n, m, p, h, b, k, v, w, x, z, qu, ll, ss, ff, zz, sh, ch, th, ck, oo, ee, or, ng, ai, oi.</p> <p>Tricky words taught so far: the, to, I, no, go, into, she, he, me, we, be, you, was, my, they, all, are, said, have, come, some.</p>	<p>Play a word hunt game-</p> <p>Write words with <b>ow</b>, <b>er</b> and <b>igh</b> in them. Hide them around your home or garden. Support your child to hunt for the words and to read them. They could then write the words for you to find!</p> <p>Your child could think of sentences that have tricky word <b>her</b> in them. Perhaps they could write the sentences. Don't forget a capital letter, finger spaces and a full stop.</p>
