What we will be doing in school	How you can help at home
<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Topic - Once Upon a Tale</u></b></p> <p>Our story next week will be <i>Goldilocks and the Three Bears</i>. We will be retelling and sequencing the story. We are using drama to help retell our stories and will begin to use mime to act out different scenes.</p> 	<p>Can your child retell The Three Billy Goats Gruff story that we have been learning this week? Try retelling Goldilocks and the Three Bears if they already know it well. Can they use interesting language, different voices, different facial expressions and actions to help make it exciting? Perhaps they can put on a puppet show of the story? Can they draw a picture from the story and add a speech bubble?</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Maths</u></b></p> <p>We will explore numbers from eleven to fifteen.</p> 	<p>Explore numbers using objects such as Lego bricks. Can your child find fourteen objects? What do they notice?</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Phonics</u></b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>New sounds:</u> air, ur</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Tricky words:</u> Recap of words taught so far</b></p> <p>Sounds taught so far: c, o, a, d, g, f, s, e, l, i, t, u, y, j, r, n, m, p, h, b, k, v, w, x, z, qu, ll, ss, ff, zz, sh, ch, th, ck, oo, oo, ee, or, ng, ai, oi, ow, er, igh.</p> <p>Tricky words taught so far: the, to, I, no, go, into, she, he, me, we, be, you, was, my, they, all, are, said, have, come, some, her.</p>	<p>You could create a tricky word Bingo game for your child to complete. They could practise writing the words.</p> <p>You could think of nonsense words with your child and take turns to read and write them.</p>
