Monday- Dress up day and Shadow Puppetry workshops

We would like the children to dress up as a character from a traditional story or a fairy tale. They could also dress up as a character from their favourite story.

What we will be doing in school	How you can help at home
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Topic - Once Upon a Tale</u></p> <p>Our story this week will be <i>Little Red Riding Hood</i>. We will continue using role-play to help bring the story to life. We will be breaking down the story into parts and making story maps to help retell the story.</p> 	<p>Can your child retell <i>The Gingerbread Man</i> from last week? Can they draw a picture and add a speech bubble or thought bubble? Can they get into character and answer questions as if they were the character? Can they use some more descriptive words when telling a story? For example, In the <u>deep</u>, <u>dark</u> forest.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <p>We will explore subtraction through games and other practical activities.</p> 	<p>Try some practical subtraction at home. For example, If you have ten toys to tidy up then put away five of them, how many are left?</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Phonics</u></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Practising: th, ar and oa</u></p> <p><u>Practising tricky words: come and said</u></p> <p>Sounds taught so far: c, o, a, d, g, f, s, e, l, i, t, u, y, j, r, n, m, p, h, b, k, v, w, x, z, qu, ll, ss, ff, zz, sh, ch, th, ck, oo, ee, or, ng, ai, oi, ow, er, igh, ur, air, oi, ear.</p> <p>Tricky words taught so far: the, to, I, no, go, into, she, he, me, we, be, you, was, my, they, all, are, said, have, come, some, her, so, do.</p>	<p>Play Snap with the sounds we have taught so far.</p> <p>You could also play Bingo with tricky words.</p>
