What we will be doing in school	How you can help at home
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Topic - Once Upon a Tale</u></p> <p>Our story next week will be <i>The Gingerbread Man</i>. We will continue using role-play to help bring the story to life. We will be getting into character and interviewing each other, thinking about the different characters' perspectives and using thought bubbles.</p> 	<p>Can your child retell <i>The Three Little Pigs</i> from last week? Can they draw a picture from the story and add a speech bubble or thought bubble? Talk about how the characters might be feeling within stories you/they read. What might they be thinking about? Are they thinking something different from what they are saying?</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <p>We will practise different ways of adding, including combining two groups of objects, and starting at a number and counting on.</p> 	<p>Try some practical addition problems, for example. I have 4 apples. I am adding 5 more to the shopping basket, how many do we have altogether?</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Phonics</u></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Sounds:</u> Recap <u>igh</u>, <u>ear</u> and <u>air</u></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Tricky words:</u> Recap of all words taught so far</p> <p>Sounds taught so far: c, o, a, d, g, f, s, e, l, i, t, u, y, j, r, n, m, p, h, b, k, v, w, x, z, qu, ll, ss, ff, zz, sh, ch, th, ck, oo, ee, or, ng, ai, oi, ow, er, igh, ur, air, oi, ear.</p> <p>Tricky words taught so far: the, to, I, no, go, into, she, he, me, we, be, you, was, my, they, all, are, said, have, come, some, her, so, do.</p>	<p>Can your child spot the tricky words we have taught in books that they are reading?</p> <p>Can your child spell these words? For example, they could write them or spell them out with magnetic letters.</p>
