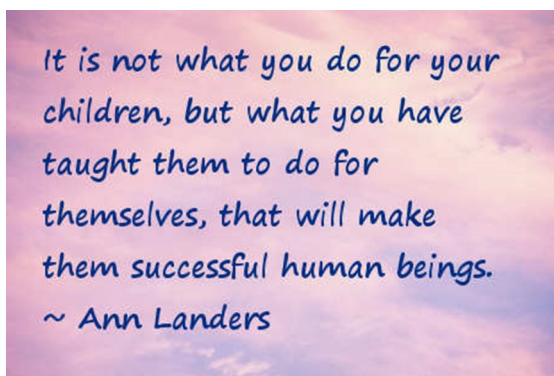


Wednesday 3rd June 2021
