


This Week in Reception

What we will be doing in school	How you can help at home
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Topic - Marvellous Minibeasts</u></p> <p>We will read the story of <i>The Very Hungry Caterpillar</i> and find out about the butterfly lifecycle with our very own class caterpillars to watch grow and change!</p>  <p>We will talk about special people in our lives.</p>	<p>Look out for real caterpillars! Where do they live? What do they eat?</p> <p>Talk about lifecycles about an animal, for example, cats and kittens; dogs and puppies; eggs, chicks and chickens; frogspawn, tadpoles, frogs.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <p>We will explore how to share and group objects. For example, we will group different objects by colour and size. We will explore how to share objects equally between two groups.</p> 	<p>Explore a group of objects with your child. Ask your child to group the objects. How did their group the objects? For example, by function, size or colour?</p> <p>You could set up a picnic for their teddies or favourite toys. How will your child share out 'food' between the picnic guests?</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Phonics</u></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Sounds we will practise: ar and ng</u></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Tricky words we will practise: have and some</u></p> <p>Sounds taught so far: c, o, a, d, g, f, s, e, l, i, t, u, y, j, r, n, m, p, h, b, k, v, w, x, z, qu, ll, ss, ff, zz, sh, ch, th, ck, oo, oo, ee, or, ng, ai, oi, ow, er, igh, ur, air, oi, ear.</p> <p>Tricky words taught so far: the, to, I, no, go, into, she, he, me, we, be, you, was, my, they, all, are, said, have, come, some, her, so, do.</p>	<p>How many objects with ar can your child spot at home? Can they make a list? For example, park, shark, sharp, cart, jar, star, bark, arch and yard. Perhaps they could write a silly sentence, for example, The shark went to the park in a cart.</p> <p>When you are reading with your child, see if they can spot the tricky words and the high frequency words.</p> <p>You could play a game of tricky word/high frequency word pairs, by writing out the words twice then cutting them out. Then you can play by placing all the words face down and turning them over two at a time to try to find a pair.</p> <p>You could use the words to play a game of Snap too.</p>
