What we will be doing in school	How you can help at home
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Topic -Super Me, Super You!</u></p> <p>Next week, we will finish our half term by thinking about how we will welcome a new member to our class- a very special someone! This will include a trip to the local post-box, as we will be posting letters to the special someone!</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div>	<p>Talk to your children about their address, road name, neighbours and favourite local places you can walk to. You could draw a simple map of their route to school or to the park.</p> <p>Perhaps your child could write a letter for a friend who lives nearby. What is their address? Can you post it through their letterbox?</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <p>We will explore positional language including over, under, above, below, on top, underneath, next to, in front of, behind and in between.</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div>	<p>Go on a hunt around the house, garden or park - ask your child to describe the place you have hidden something, for example, it is on the chair, it is behind the sofa, it is under the table, it is in between the armchair and the sofa? Can they follow your instructions to find it? Can they hide something for you to find and describe where it is hidden?</p> <p>Play Hide and Seek!</p>

Sounds learnt so far: s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d,

Tricky words taught so far: is, I
