Dear Parents/Carers,

Our value for October is 'Trust'.

Trust: firm belief in the reliability, truth or ability of someone or something.

This value can be explored in many different ways depending on the context of discussions. In school, much of our work has been around trust between friends. We will also focus strongly, as we do on a constant basis, on how children can and should trust adults in school should they have problems. Please encourage your children to think hard about this value and to trust adults in school to help them with any problems they have. We will also consider the idea that with trust, comes responsibility. If someone has trust in you, you have the responsibility to live up to that and not break that trust. By considering their feelings when trust is broken, the children can explore how important trust is.

You, as parents are in the strongest position to teach your child the meaning of certain values and the website below has some good tips on teaching your child about the value of trust.
