

Maths

This half term we will recap 2D shapes and begin to investigate 3D ones. We'll explore place value of 2-digit number before continuing working on addition and subtraction with numbers to 20.

Science

We will continue looking at animal classification.

Seasonal changes will feature again too as we look at winter and notice the changes around us a result of this season.

Computing

We will be researching, designing and making celebration cards using a simple art program.

PE

The children will be doing Invasion and Ball Skills this half term.

English

There will be a continued focus on perfecting letter formation in handwriting so we can start thinking about joining up. We will be ensuring children consistently use full stops and capital letters in the correct places along with looking at the correct use of the personal pronoun I, Suffixes will be tackled for example – ing, -ed alongside plurals. We will do this as we explore and write about key events within the 1960s.

We are being inspired by pop art of the 1960s. The artist we will be focusing on is Roy Lichtenstein. After investigation and experimentation, the children will be producing a Lichtenstein style piece of art work based on their own name.
