<p style="text-align: center;"><u>English</u></p> <p>We will discuss the nursery rhymes we are learning about. We will talk about stars, the moon and space.</p> <p>We will read How To Catch A Star and describe ideas for how we would catch a star.</p> <p>We will make Space Passports for going into space!</p>	<p>Change the words of familiar nursery rhymes to create your own nonsense rhymes. e.g. Twinkle, twinkle chocolate bar How I wish you were a car.</p> <p>Read stories about space, planets, aliens etc. Look at information books about space.</p>

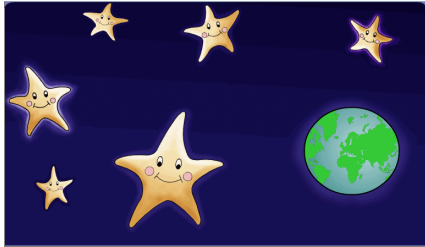
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Maths

We will practise some 2D shapes especially related to our rhymes: star, diamond, circle, crescent moon shape.

We will practise counting.
We will count stars and practise recognising numbers up to 10.



Talk about the shapes you see around you e.g. square window, circle steering wheel.

Encourage your child to count anything and everything in the world around them.

Try singing along to 5 Little Men in a Flying Saucer.

Talk about the things you see at night time. Look out at the sky when it is dark, look for the moon, stars. What do you do before you go to bed?



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We will be celebrating World Space Week by playing with toy space rockets, astronauts and making our own Space Station!
