<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Topic - Super Me, Super You!</u></b> We will learn all about our senses. Can you go on a listening walk or listen to different types of music? Perhaps you could make some delicious treats to taste and encourage your children to describe their favourite taste and smell.</p>

Ask your child to group their toys together. Do they have more blocks or cars? Can your child think of any words that begin with these sounds?</p> <p>The children will bring home reading books on Friday.</p>

Phonemes we will be focusing on this week in school -



Pronunciation Phrase - l

Pull your lips back and make the l sound at the back of your mouth l l l



Pronunciation Phrase - n

Open your lips a bit, put your tongue behind your teeth and make the nnnnn sound nnnnn



Pronunciation Phrase - m

Put your lips together and make the mmmmm sound mmmmm



Pronunciation Phrase - d

Put your tongue to the top and front of your mouth and make a quick d d d

We will be orally blending words. Can you hear the phonemes in these words? Can you listen and then repeat the word?
