




Next Week in Reception Week Beginning 26th September 2022

What we will be doing in school	How you can help at home
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Topic - Super Me, Super You!</u></p> <p>This week we are continuing our topic by thinking about our favourite people, our families and our pets. We will be talking about and drawing pictures of them.</p> 	<p>Talk to your child about their family - who lives in the same home? Where do other family members live? Who else is a special person in their lives?</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <p>We will explore repeating patterns. We will use shapes, objects and sequences of clapping and tapping to make different patterns that the children can remember and then repeat.</p> 	<p>Help your child to practise recognising patterns. Your child could get creative and paint or print patterns. They could also use beads, blocks or Lego.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Phonics and tricky words</u></p> <p>We will practise orally blending with the new graphemes (sounds) for this week.</p> <p><u>New graphemes</u> :g, o, c and k.</p>	<p>See if you can spot the graphemes we have learnt in the environment, for example, on a label, on a sign or in a book.</p> <p>Don't forget to read with your child every day. There are two books in their reading</p>

Focus - Phonemes g / o / c / k

Phonemes we will be focusing on this week in school -



Pronunciation Phrase - g

Give me a big smile that shows your teeth. Press the middle of your tongue to the top and back of your mouth; push your tongue down and forward to make the sound **g g g**



Pronunciation Phrase - o

Make your mouth into a round shape and say **o o o**



Pronunciation Phrase - c

Open your mouth into a little smile; make your tongue flat and move it up towards the top of your mouth to say **c c c**



Pronunciation Phrase - k

Open your mouth into a little smile; make your tongue flat and move it up towards the top of your mouth to say **k k k**

We will be orally blending words. Can you hear the phonemes in these words? Can you listen and then repeat the word?
