

What we will be doing in school	How you can help at home
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Topic -Trains</u></p> <p>This week we will learn about trains and railways. We will read the books <i>Oi Get of my Train</i>, <i>The Train Ride</i> and information books about trains.</p> <p>We will learn about some of the ways people travelled before trains were invented.</p> <p>We will begin to learn about the history of trains.</p> <div data-bbox="148 891 644 1281"></div>	<p>Visit a different train station. Have the children been on a train journey? Perhaps you travelled somewhere by train during the Christmas holidays.</p> <p>Why not visit the London Transport Museum or perhaps you may wish to take your child on a train journey!</p>

Can they find all of the ways to group the objects, for example, three and two?</p>

Phonics

Tricky words taught so far: is, I, the, pull,
full, put, as, and, has, his, her, go, no, to,
into, she, he, push, of, we, me, be

Practise listening for rhyming words. You could support your child to make up silly rhymes, for example, The dog and the frog sat on the log.

Play I spy with rhyming words.

Play rhyming bumps, e.g. Your child can sit down when they hear a rhyming pair of words They can think of some examples for you to spot!

Additional learning

We will go on a Nature Explorers session in our Wildlife garden to explore birds!
