What we will be doing in school	How you can help at home
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Topic - On the Move</u></p> <p>This week we will learn about space! We will focus on the book <i>The Way Back Home</i> by Oliver Jeffers, as well as reading other stories and information books about space transport. We will design and label our own flying machines and create space passports.</p> 	<p>Encourage your child to look at the moon during different stages. What do they notice?</p> <p>Research about astronauts that have been to the moon. You could find out about other planets in our solar system. Visit the library to find information books on space or stories where the characters journey to space. Plan a visit to the Science Museum to find out more about space.</p> <p>Try making a space rocket or jet pack out of junk modelling materials such as old cans, yoghurt pots, boxes or bottles.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <p>We will compare the weight of different objects.</p> 	<p>Show your child the different types of scales that you have in your home.</p> <p>You could bake something together, weighing out ingredients.</p> <p>Encourage your child to explore the weight of familiar household objects. What is the heaviest object in your home? Which object is the lightest?</p>

Sound out words for your child, can they spot the nonsense words? Encourage them to take the lead in the game. Who can think of the silliest nonsense word?</p>
