
Important Information

- 30 hour childcare code- the code will be needed <u>before</u> the start of every term. If you don't apply for and validate the code- you will have to pay- There will be nothing we can do about this!!! We know this because it has happened in the past!
- Paying yourself Payment will be via ParentPay if you are paying yourselves - childcare vouchers can be used for this.



 Meetings with the class teacher will take place during the first week in September-




Monday 4th September-all day Tuesday 5th September-all day Wednesday 6th September-pm.

- All children separate at different rates. We will work with you and your child on making this as smooth as possible. The key is flexibility.





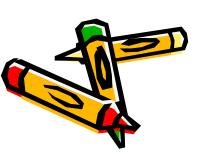
Expectations at Stillness Infant School

- Home and school working together and communicating.
- Positive behaviour is expected.....but children are here to learn what it looks like!!!
- Punctuality.
- Good attendance will help children settle and get the most out of the learning opportunities provided. Attendance is not statutory until the term before child turns five but as this is a school nursery you may forfeit your place if attendance falls below the school policy, which is 95% without good reason. Please call the school if your child is not attending.
- School uniform is preferable; otherwise sensible clothing and shoes, for messy and physical activities.
- Please label all of your child's belongings.

Medications can only be given if they are prescribed and a permission form has been completed at the office.

Safeguarding

- Safeguarding is an important part of our function as school we aim to work in partnership with parents to ensure the wellbeing and safety of the children.
- Allergies/ medical conditions- Thank you for informing us of your child's allergies/ medical conditions- please keep this information up to date.
- Photo consent- a word of warning- if we do not have the permissions in place, your child will not be on Class Dojo or in any class photos- we can not chase you on this or accept ad hoc permissions.
- Additional needs- we would appreciate as much information as possible as soon as possible to ensure a smooth start.


Class Dojo is used to update you about activities in school.



It is not to be used to report absences, pick up arrangements or concerns. Please use the official email address to report these issues.



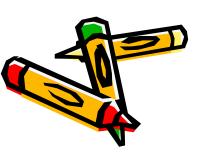




Wraparound Childcare

What happens in Nursery?






















A typical session


 Group learning on the carpet in small or larger groups - counting, phonics, rhymes, stories, circle time.

- Child initiated and adult focus activities.
- Small group activities to support and develop specific needs and skills.



How can you help at home?

- · Read to your child as often as you can.
- Sing songs and nursery rhymes.
- Play games, especially those involving turn taking.
- Ask about school activities, friends, adults, etc.
- Read the weekly email for information on what is happening in class and ideas for you at home.


