

What we will be doing in school

How you can help at home



Try reading some non-fiction books at home to find out information. Look at the contents page and discuss how to use it. What do bears do to prepare for hibernation? Talk about and use question words: where, when, what, why, who, how. Look out for questions and question marks when you are reading with your child.

Do you have an Advent Calendar at home? How many numbers does it have on it? What traditions do you have in your family around Advent or preparing for Christmas?



We will continue to learn about bears and find out more about hibernation.

We will talk about Christmas traditions and our countdown to Christmas.

The children will also write numbered lists about how to prepare for Christmas.

Maths

We are learning about 2D and 3D shapes this week. We will use mathematical language - face, vertices and edges and looking for 2D shapes within 3D shapes. Can your child spot any shapes around the home or outside? Are they 2D or 3D?

Phonics

New graphemes: No new graphemes this week.

We will be reviewing adding 's' (e.g. chips, digs) (sometimes sounds like 'z e.g. bags, rings) at the end of words for plurals and verb forms

New tricky words: we, me, be

<u>Graphemes learnt so far</u>: s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c, k, ck, e, u, r, II, ff, j, ss, v, w, x, y, z, qu, ch, sh, th, ng, nk

Tricky words taught so far: is, I, the, pull, full, put, as, and, has, his, her, go, no, to, into, she, push, he, of

Try a robot game: Draw a picture and encourage your child to move as a robot as they say each sound. For example, f- r-o-g. Encourage emphasis on each sound. Don't forget to have a go yourself!

Create a tricky word Bingo game to play together. Your child could try writing the words.
