| What we will be doing in school | How you can help at home |
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## Maths

We are learning about 2D and 3D shapes this week. We will use mathematical language - face, vertices and edges and looking for 2D shapes within 3D shapes.

## Phonics

New graphemes: No new graphemes this week.
We will be reviewing adding 's' (e.g. chips, digs) (sometimes sounds like 'z e.g. bags, rings) at the end of words for plurals and verb forms

New tricky words: we, me, be

Graphemes learnt so far: $s, a, t, p, i, n, m$, $d, g, o, c, k, c k, e, u, r, I I, f f, j, s s, v, w, x$, $y, z, q u, c h, s h, t h, n g, n k$

Tricky words taught so far: is, I, the, pull, full, put, as, and, has, his, her, go, no, to, into, she, push, he, of

Can your child spot any shapes around the home or outside? Are they 2D or 3D?

Try a robot game: Draw a picture and encourage your child to move as a robot as they say each sound. For example, f-r-o-g. Encourage emphasis on each sound. Don't forget to have a go yourself!

Create a tricky word Bingo game to play together. Your child could try writing the words.
