Talk to your child about the different days we have coming up and what they're for!








Maths

This week in maths we will dive deeper into our knowledge of number! We will focus on 7 and 8, exploring different ways to make them.

We will be continuing our work on part-whole models, seeing how two parts add together to make the whole.

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Phonics

<u>Focus of the week:</u> Reviewing the sounds and tricky words taught this term!

Review the taught sounds and ensure children are able to recognise them as they are written, find them within words and can write them if dictated aloud.

When reading books, can you spot any two syllable words? Practise 'chunking' them up, e.g. sunset = sun / set. Read half the word at a time then put them back together to read the full word.

Keep reviewing the taught sounds, ensuring children can read them and spot them within words! Become digraph detectives, hunting for digraphs in the words before trying to read them!
