Thursday 7th March- World Book Day! Don't forget that the children can come dressed as any book character they like.







You can also do some fractions practically cutting up fruits, vegetables, sandwiches. Whenever you are serving food ask your child to help you prepare cutting the food into fractions of differing amounts so they see the correlation of the fraction and the object.

<u>Art</u>

The theme for art this term will be Rainforest Art!

This week the children will be practising how to mix colours together. They will revisit the colour wheels they learned about in Year 1, where they will be reminded about complementary colours plus different shades and tones.



The children will also be analysing the colours used in Amazonian artwork so that they can make an informed choice of the colours they will use when they create their own piece of Rainforest art.

<u>PSHE</u>

In PSHE the children will continue to discover how to maintain their physical and mental health by understanding that the effects that our choices have on our bodies. The children will be learning how to avoid spreading diseases by learning to maintain their own personal hygiene.
