How you can help at home

Maths-

This week the children will be learning about time!
They will revisit their learning from Year One, recapping recognising 'o'clock' and half past times.
They will then further their knowledge by learning quarter to and quarter past before moving into learning about telling the time to five minutes.

Read some clocks! Have your child recognise the time on clocks you have at home, can they spot where the minute hand is? The hour hand? Do they know what language to use when the minute hand is before & after the 6?

Science

In Science this week the children will term, our topic will be Living things and their Habitats.

It's all about our ducklings during Science Week as we watch them grow and learn, from hatching from their shell to even experiencing their first paddle in the water.

What do ducklings need to survive? How quickly do they grow? How fast can they run?








<u>Art</u>

<u>P.E.</u>


We have two PE sessions each week.
