What we will be doing in school	How you can help at home
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Topic - Get Set, Grow</u></p> <p>We will introduce our new topic, <i>Get Set, Grow</i>.</p> <p>We will talk about our experiences during the school holiday.</p>	<p>Discuss things which grow with your child. Encourage them to describe what they notice.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"></p> <p>Talk about the things your child can do now that they couldn't do when they were a baby.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"></p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Literacy</u></p> <p>We will practise blending words spoken aloud.</p> <p>We will read stories about growing.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"></p>	<p>Play I-Spy with objects, for example, I-Spy a c-a-t.</p> <p>Ask your child to describe what they have noticed growing, for example, plants and trees or their brother and sisters growing taller!</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <p>We will practise matching numerals and quantity using 'seeds' and pots.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"></p>	<p>Encourage your child to look at numbers at home and in the local environment.</p> <p>Try counting out some seeds into some plant pots. You can use anything to be the seeds such as stones, pom-poms, beads or dry beans, or playdough. You could label the pots with different numbers so your child can practise counting out the amount to match the number on the pots.</p>

We will explore bark and make rubbings of the different textures they make.



We will learn about the things plants need to grow.
