What we will be doing in school	How you can help at home
Topic - Get Set, Grow	
We will introduce our new topic, Get Set, Grow.	Discuss things which grow with your child. Encourage them to describe what they notice.
We will talk about our experiences during the school holiday.	
	Talk about the things your child can do now that they couldn't do when they were a baby.
<u>Literacy</u>	Play T Spy with objects for example T Spy a c a
We will practise blending words spoken aloud.	Play I-Spy with objects, for example, I-Spy a c-a-t.
We will read stories about growing.	Ask your child to describe what they have noticed growing, for example, plants and trees or their brother and sisters growing taller!
<u>Maths</u>	
We will practise matching numerals and quantity using 'seeds' and pots.	Encourage your child to look at numbers at home and in the local environment.  Try counting out some seeds into some plant pots. You can use anything to be the seeds such as stones, pom-poms, beads or dry beans, or playdough. You could label the pots with different numbers so your child can practise counting out the amount to match the number on the pots.

We will explore the mud kitchen.



We will explore our new gardeners' role-play area.

We will explore bark and make rubbings of the different textures they make.



We will learn about the things plants need to grow.
